



ATTACHMENT A – ANTI DOPING 2010

Some medication for Asthma, ADHD and other ailments are on the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) “**Prohibited List**”.

All COMPETITIVE Level Members of Skate Australia who are or who have ever taken Medications for Asthma, ADHD, Diabetes or other medications should complete the information below so that Skate Australia’s Sports Medicine Commission can provide you with information as to whether you are required to apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption TUE, Declaration of Use or whether the medications you are taking are permitted both in and out of competition.

If you already have a current TUE and have NOT CHANGED your medication you are not required to return the form. However if you have a current TUE and HAVE CHANGED your medication you should also complete the information so that our records can be updated and your new medication can be checked by Skate Australia’s Sports Medicine Commission.

Remember it is up to you whether you notify or not. However, if you choose not to provide the information requested and you are asked to undergo a Drug Test (either in or out of competition) you could record a positive test.
